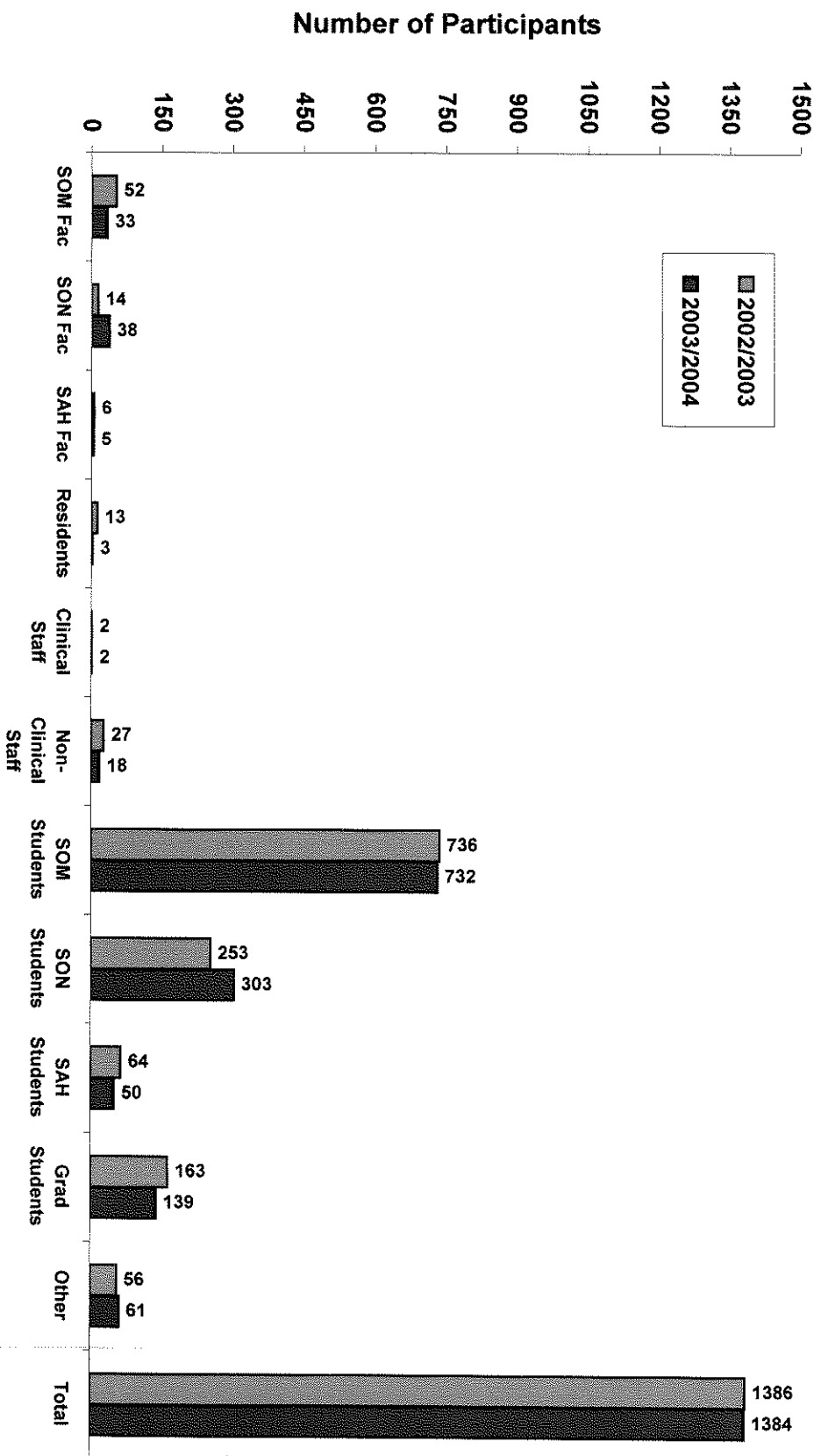

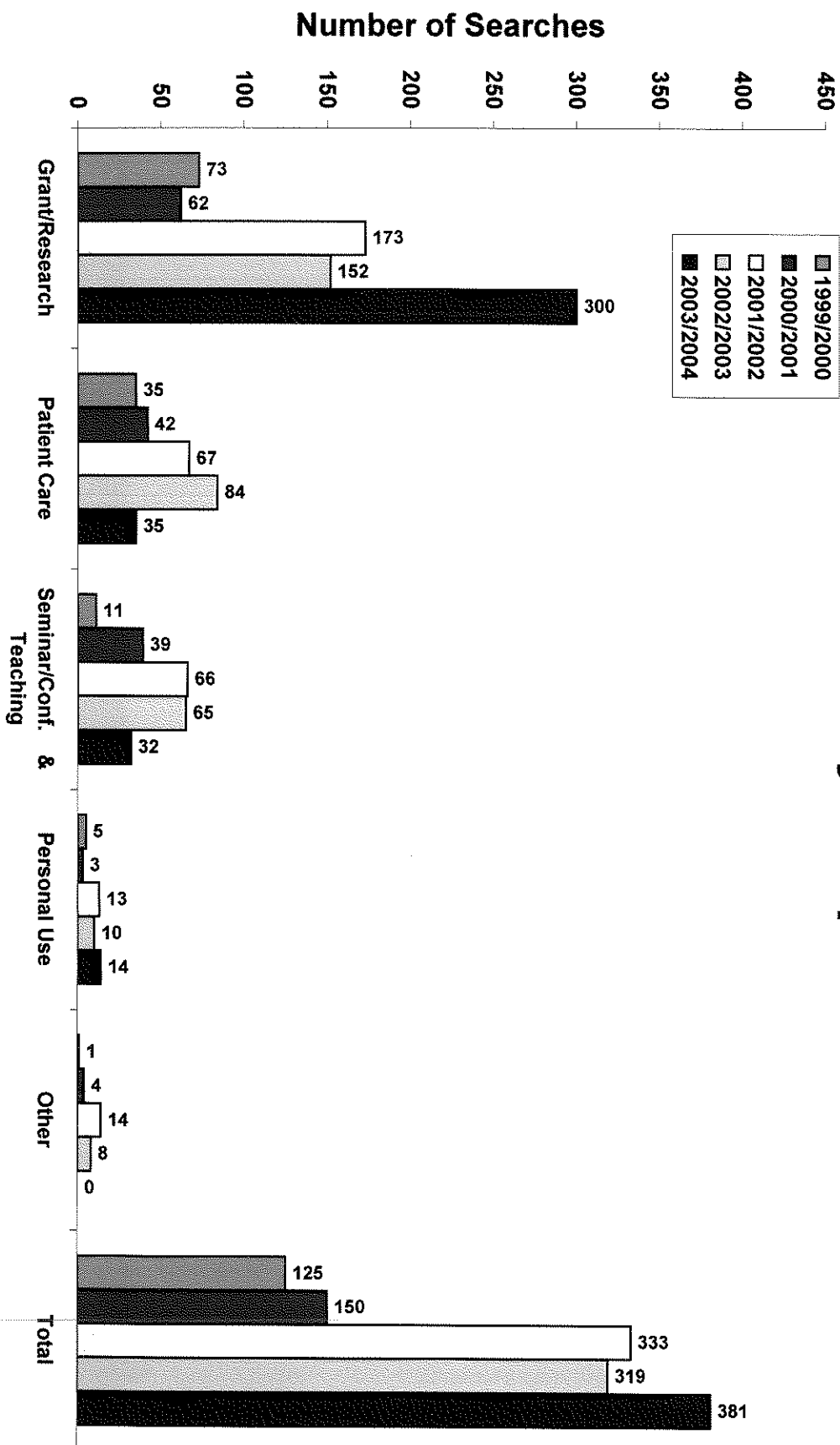
Tour Orientation Sessions



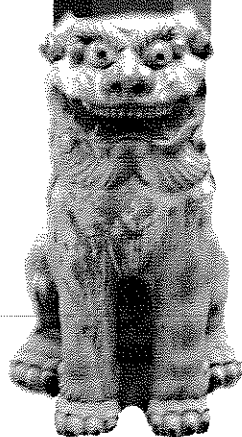
Educational Contacts by Participant Status

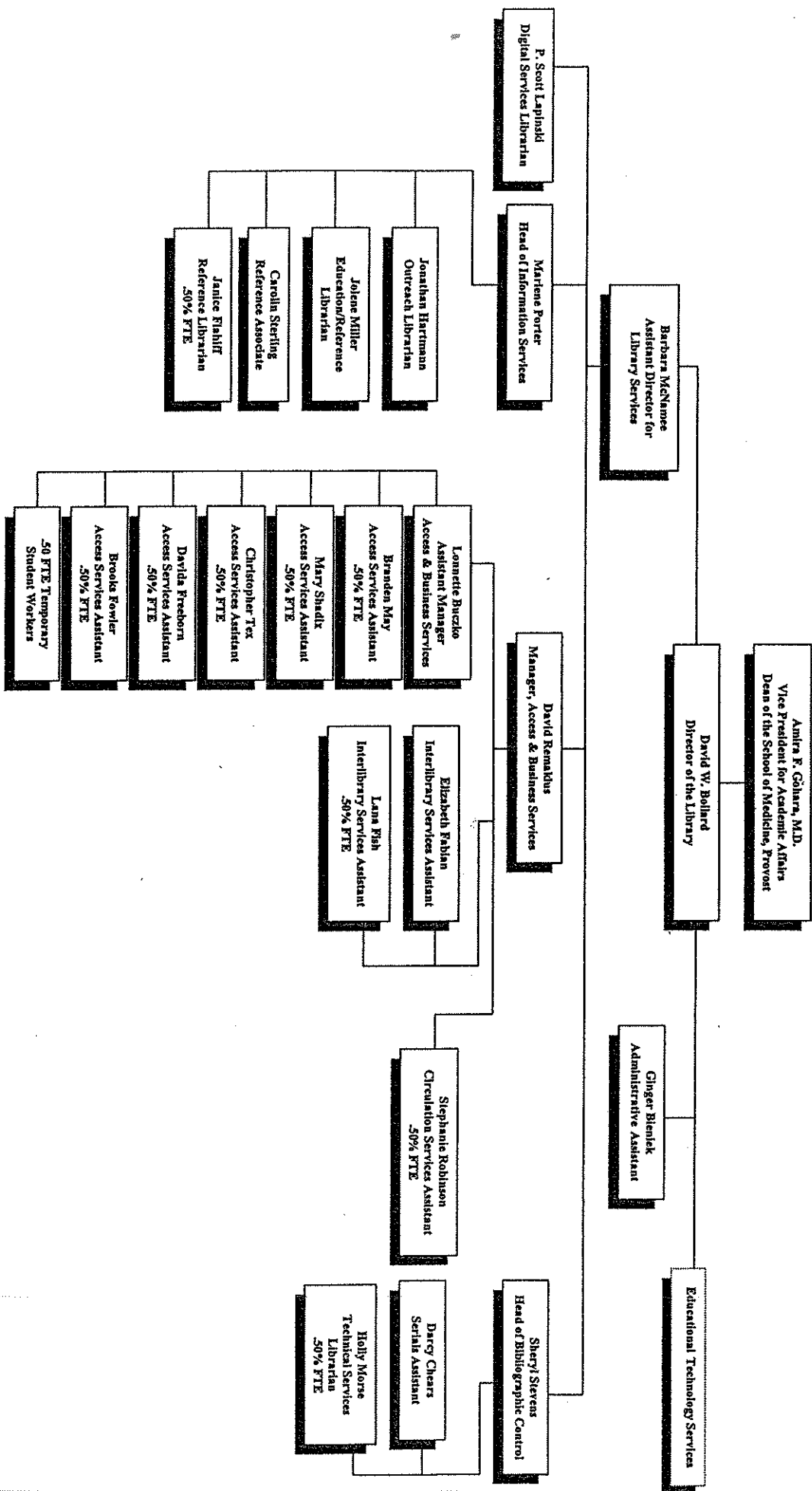
